### **HEAD START PROGRAM**

The following are needed to complete an application:

Proof of child's age

Proof of income

Head Start children must be 3 or 4 years old by September 1, 2021

### **PRE-K slots are filled using a lottery system.**

Come to the Head Start/Pre-K office beginning March 1, 2021 to put your child's name on the wait list.

Items needed to have on file prior to or on the first day the child begins Pre-K:

Proof of child's age

Child's Social Security Card (if available)

Proof of Residency

Children must be 4 years old by September 1, 2021 for the Pre-K program.

Head Start /Pre-K also serves children with disabilities.

Service is provided for all children who qualify, regardless of race, sex, creed, religion or disability.

**There is no charge for eligible families.**
