

## Supply List for Towns County

### Kindergarten Classes

- Book bag (non rolling)- folder must fit inside without bending
- Zippered pencil pouch
- box of 16 or 24 count Crayola crayons
- 6 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 inch 3 ring white binder with clear cover pocket
- Scissors (fiskars brand works best)
- Mat for rest time and a small towel to cover with, No pillows
- Change of clothes

As you are buying items for school, please think and buy supplies to have at home to do homework with.

# First Grade Supply List 2014-2015

- Small plastic pencil box
- Student Scissors
- Primary Composition Writing Tablet...the brand "MEAD" seems to hold up best (fully lined page...no space needed for picture)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 4 glue sticks
- 4 packs #2 pencils (wooden without plastic coating)
- 2 large pink erasers
- (1) One subject **wide ruled** spiral notebook (used for writing and math journal)
- (2) Two pocket folders of choice **without** prongs (used for homework and reading log)

\*\*Please label each item with your child's name using a permanent marker.

\*\*It would also be a good idea to put his/her name on jackets, coats, etc.

\*\*No pencil sharpeners please

## Second Grade Supply List

- 4 Pack Glue Sticks
- 1 Pair Student Scissors
- 3 Folders with Pockets (without brads) – RED, YELLOW, BLUE
- 1 Pocket Folder With Picture (of your choice)
- 3 Packs of Pencils (10 -12 count)
- 1 Pack Pencil Top Erasers
- 1 Box of Crayons (24 count)
- 1 Pack of Washable Markers
- 1 Yellow Highlighter
- 1 Pencil Box (recommended size 8 1/2" X 5 3/4" X 2 1/2")
- 1 – One Inch 3-Ring Binder
  
- Optional Colored Pencils

## **Third Grade Supply List—Towns County Elementary School 2014-2015**

1. Two packages loose-leaf, **wide ruled** notebook paper (**Not college ruled**)
2. 1 package #2 wooden pencils with erasers
3. Crayons—no larger than 24 count
4. Scissors (“Fiskars” brand cuts neater)
5. One red pen (for editing)
6. One small crayon/pencil storage box
7. One bookbag or backpack (**NOT rolling bookbags**)
8. Two one-subject **wide ruled** spiral notebooks (for classwork)
9. Two black and white marble composition books (for math and science journals)
10. One red two pocket folder with clasps (for reading log)
11. One 1 inch white binder with clear overlay pocket (for writing portfolio)
12. One glue stick
13. One blue two pocket folder with clasps (for math classwork)

**PLEASE:** Do not purchase trapper keeper or mechanical pencils.  
Do not label anything except coats, jackets and pencil pouches with your child’s name.

# Supply List for Fourth Grade

Qty: Description of Supply

- 1: 1 ½ inch hard binder (to help organize classroom assignments)
- 1: zippered pencil pouch (no boxes)
- 5: spiral 1-subject notebooks

- 5: Hole punched folders (no metal prongs)
- 4: Glue Sticks
- 2: packs of index cards (4x6)
- 1: spiral 3-subject notebook
- 1: Pack of colored Pencils
- 2: Expo Markers

Your child will be responsible for making sure that he/she has pencils, erasers, and college rule paper every day. We recommend that your purchase these items at the beginning of the school year, as they are much cheaper than throughout the remainder of the year.

## 2014 – 2015 Fifth Grade Supply List

- (2) 1 inch 3 ring binders (writing and math portfolios)
- (1) ½ inch 3 ring binder (social studies)
- (1) One- subject spiral notebook (ELA)
- (1) Zipper Style pencil pouch or pencil box (used to store daily materials listed below)
- (2) Pkg. (1.5x2) sticky notes (reading, science, and writing)
- (1) Pkg. index cards (4x6) ( reading and science)
- (3) Composition notebooks/sewn binding (reading, social studies, and science)

- **These items will need to be re-supplied throughout the year. Purchase what you feel your child will need as these items are cheaper. These items will need to be kept in their pencil pouch or box and kept in book bag.**

- (1) Red ink pen
- (1) Eraser ( the large pink ones work well)
- (2) Expo markers (for individual white boards in math)
- (1) pkg. Colored Pencils
- (2) Personal pencil sharpeners
- (1 each) Highlighters/pink, green, yellow
- (1) Pair of Fiskars scissors
- Glue Sticks

- **To be kept in homeroom and will need to be re-supplied throughout the year.**
- Packs of wide ruled paper
