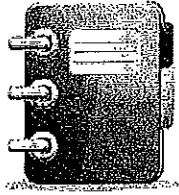
Language Arts - Mrs. Chambers

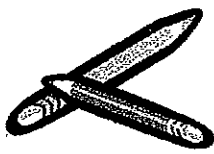

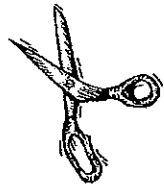

- * Dividers (8 count)

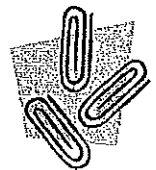
Science
