- 3) **Senior Portraits**: Precious Memories will be offering cap and gown pictures for those who are interested; with the packet you will receive an individual portrait, group picture of the class, and a picture of you receiving your diploma; the individual portraits will be made on May 25 (Tuesday) starting at 9:30 am
- 4) **Graduation Practice**: May 28 (Friday) at 10:00 am in High School Gym; please be on time so we can get practice done as quickly as possible
- 5) **Graduation Ceremony**: May 28 (Friday) at 7:00 pm in the High School Gym; wear dress clothes (no flip flops, shorts, or jeans); girls should wear a white dress with white dress shoes or sandals; boys should wear dark dress pants, dark dress shoes, white dress shirt, and tie. Be in the middle school gym no later than 5:45 pm!! We will have a group photo taken before graduation; this is a memorable occasion so look your best and act your best!
