

Seniors: Before You Get Your Diploma

REMINDERS:

1. Pass your classes
2. Pay all outstanding debts so you are eligible to walk
 - ✓ Lunchroom
 - ✓ Club/Organization

3. Check regularly with Mrs. Parker for scholarships and give teachers as much notice as possible (at least 4-5 days) for Letters of Recommendation
4. Send handwritten "Thank You" notes to any and everyone who gives you a scholarship or graduation gift!
5. Graduates should order invitations if not already. It is respectful to send out invitations at least three weeks ahead of time. Please don't send to teachers or school employees unless you're just giving them as a keepsake.

- ✿ **Friday, May 18** – Graduation Rehearsal at 10 a.m. Towns County Conference Center
 - Those graduates who are speaking or singing will stay to rehearse after others leave
- ✿ **Friday, May 18** – Graduation – 7 p.m. Towns County Conference Center, Foster Park Please arrive no later than 5:15 p.m. to get class group picture and line up.
 - Dress Code for Girls – same
 - Dress Code for Boys – same
 - Park by tennis courts on side of building
 - Graduates must be in cap and gown in order to participate
 - Parents, family, and friends are welcome to attend – since parking will be limited, carpooling is suggested. This is a very serious event – please be respectful of your parents and classmates.
